### ACCOUNTABILITY PROCESS

#### STAGE 1

Student-teacher one on one resolution.

#### STAGE 4

Student and Year Level Coordinator meet with Deputy Principal to determine appropriate course of action of behaviour.

#### STAGE 2

Student and teacher meet to determine appropriate consequences and course of action for behaviour. Pastoral Care Teacher to be informed of persisting or escalated problem.

#### STAGE 5

Student, Year Level Coordinator, Deputy Principal and parents meet regarding student progress.

#### STAGE 3

Student, teacher and Year Level Coordinator meet to determine appropriate consequences and course of action. Interview with parent(s) and notification issued to student. Behaviour recorded.

#### STAGE 6

Deputy Principal and Principal review enrolment status with parents.
